Any student attending a Red Lion Christian Academy banquet must abide by the rules for formal/semi-formal events set forth by the Red Lion Christian Academy administration. If the student is not currently in high school, all information must be completed with the parent's signature replacing that of the administrator.

RULES:

- Guests may not be older than 19 or must be a high school student. Exceptions may be made by the administration for former RLCA students.
- Guests of the same gender as the RLCA student must either be:
 - A former RLCA student
 - A relative of an RLCA student
 - A prospective RLCA student

- Guests who do not attend RLCA must fill out and return a Guest Permission form at least 2 weeks prior to the event and have it approved before an RLCA student may purchase a ticket for him or her.
- Alcohol or drug use before or during the event is strictly prohibited. If this is suspected the police will be contacted.
- Students or guests may not leave the banquet and reenter.
- Dress for the event is either formal or semi-formal. Students will not be admitted without meeting the appropriate dress requirements (Prom dresses must be approved before tickets can be purchased). A student or guest will be asked to leave without refund if her dress is considered immodest.
 - Gentlemen must wear a jacket and tie. Shirts remain tucked and ties worn throughout the course of the event.
 - Ladies must be dressed modestly
 - Any dress that is tight, scant, backless, see-through, low in the neckline which allows immodest cleavage to show, or revealing the midriff (in any position) is unacceptable.
 - Strapless dresses are permitted, but must be modest.
 - The back of dress should be solid or contain an insert.
 - Appropriate undergarments must be worn.
 - No spandex or extremely tight fitting garments.
 - Dress length must be modest (no higher than 4 inches above the knee) and allow complete freedom of movement without being revealing.
 - A slit in a long dress should extend no higher than 4" above the knee.
 - The determination of modesty lies solely at the discretion of RLCA's administration.
- For those that attend the after-party that follows the Junior Senior Prom the following requirements must be followed.
 - Students that leave the hall after the banquet or after-party may not reenter.
 - Dance styles that are deemed vulgar by a chaperone are not acceptable. Any chaperone may politely request that a RLCA student and/or guest adjust their dance style and/or leave the dance floor. Should a chaperone make such a request the student and/or guest is expected to comply in a polite manner.
